

**Neil Moulden** is the Chief Executive and Company Secretary of Derbyshire Dales Council for Voluntary Service, and has held this post since 2004, having joined the CVS in 2002. In addition to this he is currently a Director and Trustee of Rural Action Derbyshire. He is also a Board and Executive Committee member of the High Peak and Derbyshire Dales Local Strategic Partnership; a Board member of Third Sector Support for Derbyshire (3D) and is a member of the Leader Local Action Group.
