

Welcome to the Derbyshire Dales Community Champion Update

➤ Testing in the Derbyshire Dales

Between 13 December 2021 and 19 December 2021, there have been **11,931** tests.

➤ Cases in Derbyshire Dales

95 new people had a confirmed positive test result reported on 20 December 2021.

Between 14 December 2021 and 20 December 2021, **411** people had a confirmed positive test result.

This shows an increase of **66.4%** compared to the previous 7 days.

➤ Vaccinations in Derbyshire Dales

60,714 people had been given a first dose by the end of 19 December 2021.

57,171 people had been given a second dose by the end of 19 December 2021.

➤ Healthcare in Chesterfield Royal Hospital NHS Foundation Trust

Between 6 December 2021 and 12 December 2021, **18** went into hospital with coronavirus. This shows a decrease of **-21.7%** compared to the previous 7 days.

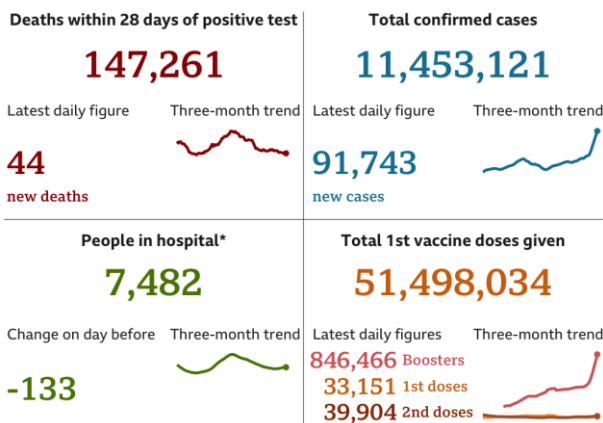
There were **27** patients in hospital with coronavirus on 14 December 2021.

➤ Deaths in Derbyshire Dales

Between 14 December 2021 and 20 December 2021, there have been **0** deaths within 28 days of a positive coronavirus test. This shows a decrease of **-100.0%** compared to the previous 7 days.

Coronavirus in the UK

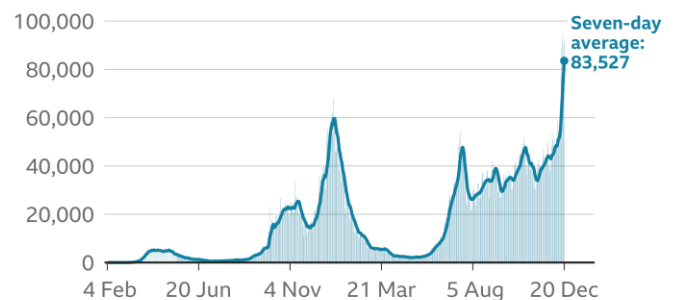
