

Welcome to the Derbyshire Dales Community Champion Update

Happy New Year! As we move into 2022, COVID-19 continues to be a topic of conversation, in the news daily and still a cause of worry for many people in our Communities. Over the next few months, the Community Champion Update will share with you the latest Covid data for the Derbyshire Dales, Government updates as well as local Health and Wellbeing information.

➤ Testing in the Derbyshire Dales

There were **2,270** tests reported on 9 January 2022. This shows an increase of **64.3%** compared to the previous 7 days.

➤ Cases in Derbyshire Dales

127 new people had a confirmed positive test result reported on 10 January 2022. Between 4 January 2022 and 10 January 2022, **1,003** people had a confirmed positive test result. This shows a decrease of **9.4%** compared to the previous 7 days.

➤ Vaccinations in Derbyshire Dales

61,073 people had been given a first dose by the end of 9 January 2022.

58,017 people had been given a second dose by the end of 9 January 2022.

49,778 people had been given a booster or third dose by the end of 9 January 2022.

➤ Healthcare in Chesterfield Royal Hospital NHS Foundation Trust

16 people with coronavirus went into hospital on 2 January 2022.

Between 27 December 2021 and 2 January 2022, **76** went into hospital with coronavirus. This shows an increase of **100.0%** compared to the previous 7 days.

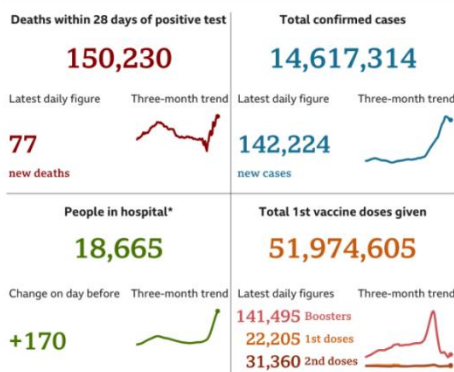
There were **61** patients in hospital with coronavirus on 4 January 2022.

➤ Deaths in Derbyshire Dales

Between 4 January 2022 and 10 January 2022, there has been **1** death within 28 days of a positive coronavirus test. This shows no change compared to the previous 7 days.

Coronavirus in the UK

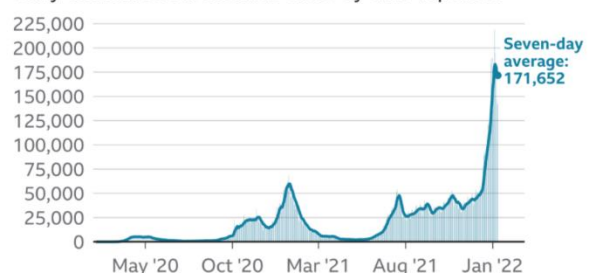
