LATEST COVID-19 UPDATES:

• Testing in the Derbyshire Dales

Between 13 June 2022 and 19 June 2022, there have been 1,709 tests. This shows an increase of 0.4% compared to the previous 7 days.

• Cases in Derbyshire Dales

Between 9 June 2022 and 15 June 2022, 18 people had a confirmed positive test result. This shows an increase of 125.0% compared to the previous 7 days.

• Vaccinations in Derbyshire Dales

61,587 given a first dose by the end of 19 June 2022.
59,937 given a second dose by the end of 19 June 2022.
52,362 given a booster or third dose by the end of 19 June 2022.

The [national release of vaccination statistics](#) by the NHS on Thursday, indicates that Derbyshire continues to vaccinate people at a good pace.

• Healthcare in Chesterfield Royal Hospital NHS Foundation Trust

Between 6 June 2022 and 12 June 2022, 20 went into hospital with coronavirus. This shows an increase of 566.7% compared to the previous 7 days.

There were 12 patients in hospital with coronavirus on 14 June 2022.

• Deaths in Derbyshire Dales

Between 9 June 2022 and 15 June 2022, there have been 0 deaths within 28 days of a positive coronavirus test.

What is cervical screening?

Cervical screening is a way of preventing cervical cancer (cancer of the cervix). It uses tests to find abnormal changes in the cells of the cervix. Regular cervical cancer screening is important for anyone with a cervix. This includes women, trans men and people assigned female at birth.
