Welcome to the Derbyshire Dales Community Voice Update

LATEST COVID-19 UPDATES:

• Testing in the Derbyshire Dales

Between 1 December 2022 and 7 December 2022, there have been 285 tests. This shows an increase of 209.8% compared to the previous 7 days.

• Cases in Derbyshire Dales

Between 27 November 2022 and 3 December 2022, 0 - 2 people had a confirmed positive test result.

• Vaccinations in Derbyshire Dales

61,436 people had been given a first dose by the end of 7 December 2022.

59,969 people had been given a second dose by the end of 7 December 2022.

52,770 people had been given a booster or third dose by the end of 7 December 2022.

• Healthcare in Chesterfield Royal Hospital NHS

Between 29 November 2022 and 5 December 2022, 18 went into hospital with coronavirus. This shows an increase of 5.9% compared to the previous 7 days. There were 10 patients in hospital with coronavirus on 7 December 2022.

• Deaths in Derbyshire Dales

Between 27 November 2022 and 3 December 2022, there have been 0 deaths within 28 days of a positive coronavirus test.

Group A Strep (GAS)
Parents should trust their judgement when their child is poorly. Speak to your GP or call 111 if your child is poorly and getting worse.

Always call 999 or go to A&E if your child:

- ▶ Is having difficulty breathing - such as grunting noises or their tummy sucking under their ribs
- ▶ there are pauses when your child breathes
- ▶ child's skin, tongue or lips are blue
- ▶ is floppy and will not wake up or stay awake.
